<p>Outcome 1 – Children have a strong sense of identity</p> <p>In preschool we are extending on our knowledge of being a good friend and how we treat others by exploring our feelings and how they might look on different people.</p> <p>We have also developed our kindness wall where we “catch” the children doing kind things for each other or in preschool and celebrating and recognising these achievements as a class.</p>		<p>Outcome 2 – Children are connected with and contribute to their world</p> <p>The children have shown a real interest in animals, in particular farm animals. We have started to explore what the children know about farms. We will investigate the different types of farms, the equipment used on farms as well as how to look after plants and animals.</p>		<p>Outcome 3 – Children have a strong sense of wellbeing</p> <p>We have been learning about listening to each other in our play and respecting what each other has to say, and we are now focusing on the children using these skills in their play. They are making up new games together in which they come up with the rules.</p>
<p>Outcome 4 – Children are confident and involved learners</p> <p>The children are becoming more confident in sharing what they know and what they would like to know with the teachers and other children, and will often use not only the teachers to help them with their learning but each other. We can see this in their questions, when they copy what someone is doing or they talk themselves through a process.</p>			<p>Outcome 5 – Children are effective communicators</p> <p>The children are showing an interest in common stories like the 3 Little Pigs. We are exploring the storytelling process in lots of different ways like through books, technology, drama, puppets and verbally. This helps them to really understand the different concepts in the story as well and practice the language in a familiar and safe way, both verbally and non-verbally.</p>
