








# Preschool - Learning From Home



These suggested activities can be used to learn while playing at home. Complete between 5 and 8 of the following learning activities. You can also complete some of the worksheets attached. You do not need to do all of the activities or worksheets. You can contact Mrs Donaldson and Miss Le on SeeSaw to share the learning happening at home and to ask any questions.

<p><b>Drawing</b> Set up an area for art and craft with pencils, crayons and paper. You could draw a picture of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your family</li> <li>• Your home</li> <li>• Your favourite animal</li> <li>• Characters from a book or tv show you like</li> </ul> 	<p><b>Listen to reading</b></p>  <p>Get an adult to read you a story every day. Talk about everything you can see in the pictures. You can also listen to stories using Storyline Online on YouTube or at <a href="https://www.storylineonline.net/">https://www.storylineonline.net/</a></p>	<p><b>Help at home</b> Help your family with jobs around the house:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hanging up the washing helps build strong muscles in your hands, which helps with writing</li> <li>• Help with cooking, to learn about counting and measuring.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>Make and play with play dough</b></p> <p>Recipe:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1/2 cup salt</li> <li>• 1 cup plain flour</li> <li>• 2 tbs cream of tartar</li> <li>• 1 cup water</li> <li>• 1 tbs oil</li> <li>• 3 drops liquid food colouring</li> </ul> <p>Method</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Mix all ingredients together in a medium-sized saucepan.</li> <li>2. Stir over heat until dough is pliable.</li> </ol> <p>Allow to cool, and store in a well-sealed plastic bag or container.</p>	<p><b>Construction</b></p>  <p>Fold paper planes and see how far they will fly. <p><b>Construction</b> Make a car track with sticky tape/masking tape</p> 	<p><b>Movement</b> Go exploring in your garden or at the park see if you can count and find different types of birds/insects record what you find on a piece of paper.</p>	<p><b>Movement</b> Superhero workouts on YouTube.</p> <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=en15HT_4sbM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=en15HT_4sbM</a></p>	<p><b>Sensory</b> Enjoy some sensory fun with some shaving cream in the shower. When they are done wash it off.</p> 	<p><b>Construction</b> Build the highest block tower you can. What can make the blocks less likely to fall over.</p> 

### Patterns

Practice making patterns with different things like colours, cars, beads, pencils and Lego. Have the children what they have decide what their pattern is.



### Movement

Create an obstacle course with chalk or masking tape.



### Dance



Have a Living Room disco – play freeze, musical chairs, have a dance off. Sing and be silly.

### Cooking

Make a sandwich or favorite food together. Talk about the ingredients that go in, how much and what each ingredient tasks like by itself.

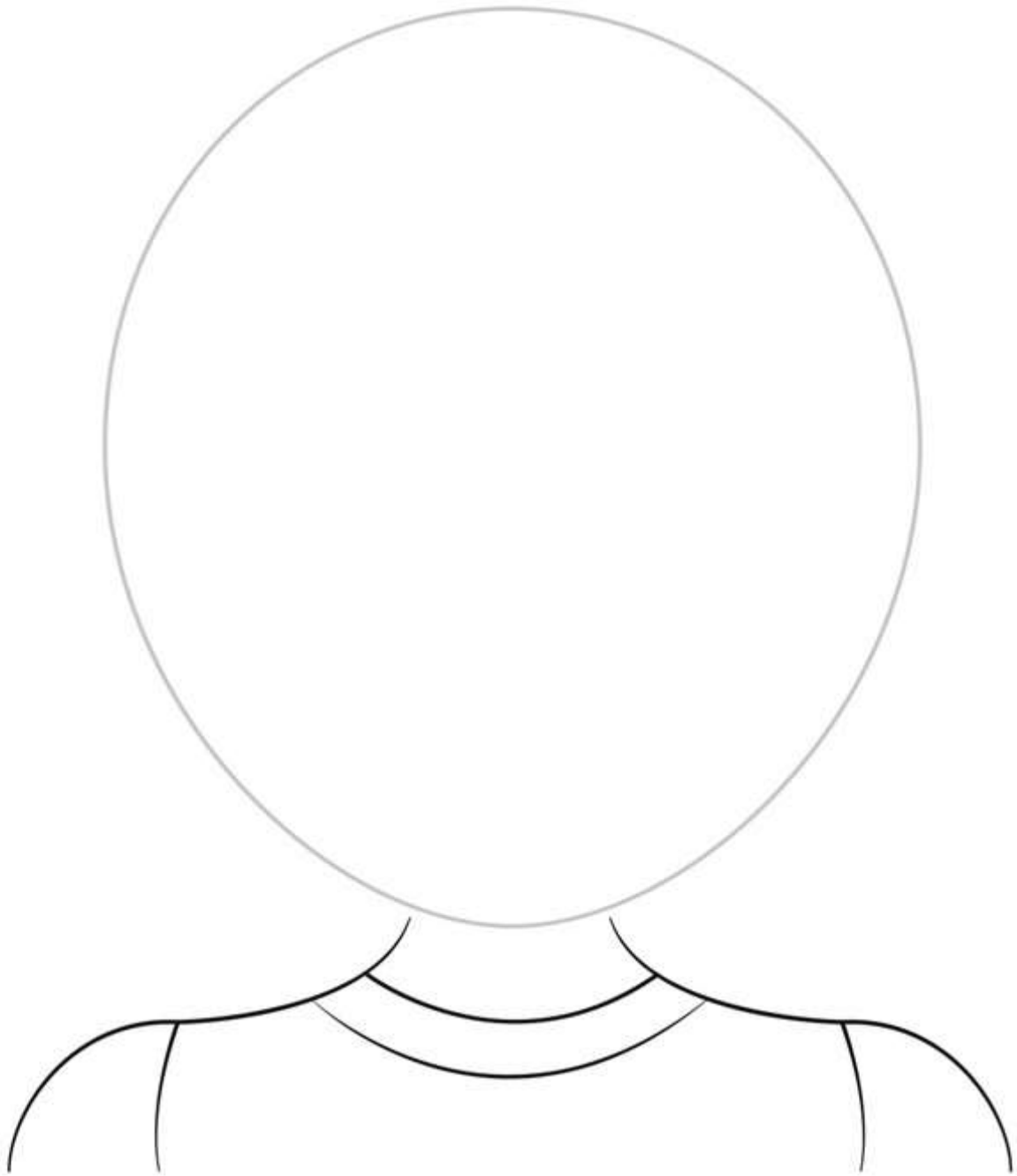


### Construction
