









# Preschool – Learning from Home – Week 7

<p><b>Cooking (L.O 1.4, 4.4)</b> Strawberry Frozen Yoghurt Bark</p>  <p>Ingredients: Vanilla Yoghurt 1 kg, frozen strawberries (defrost)</p> <p>Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Line a flat pan with baking paper and spread the yoghurt evenly.</li> <li>2.Sprinkle on the strawberry and freeze for a few hours until completely frozen.</li> <li>3.Remove yoghurt from the pan and peel away baking paper. Break into pieces and enjoy.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Science Experiment (L.O 4.2, 5.1)</b> Water in a bag pencil experiment</p> <p>Provide a plastic Ziplock bag, sharp pencil, and water.</p> <p>Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Fill the bag about <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> with water and seal it shut.</li> <li>2.Make sure your pencil is sharpened.</li> <li>3. Hold up the bag with one hand and use the other hand to firmly push the pointy end of the pencil through the side of the bag until it comes out the other side. Observe what happens!</li> </ol>	<p><b>Sensory (L.O 1.3, 4.2)</b> Taste Safe Blocks</p> <p>Ingredients: aeroplane jelly packets, bowl, boiling water, silicone cube trays.</p> <p>Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Pour jelly packet into a bowl and add 1 cup of boiling water to the jelly crystals and stir until dissolved.</li> <li>2.Distribute the mixture into the ice cube trays and place in the fridge to set for about 4 hours.</li> <li>3.Once set, place in a bowl, and enjoy the taste and touch.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Environmental Sustainability (2.4, 4.4)</b> Egg Carton Glasses</p>  <p>Trim the egg carton cups with scissors and cut a hole in the bottom of each one for the eye opening.</p> <p>Decorate your glasses. Use a toothpick to poke a hole on the opposite side of each egg</p>	<p><b>Science Experiment (L.O 4.2, 5.1)</b> Dancing Rice</p> <p>Ingredients: vinegar, baking soda, rice, clear jar, water</p> <p>Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Fill the jar with <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> of water.</li> <li>2.Add 1 Tsp of baking soda and stir.</li> <li>3.Add <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> cup of uncooked rice.</li> <li>4.Add 1-2 Tsp of vinegar to the jar and watch the rice dance!</li> </ol>
<p><b>Dramatic Play (L.O 1.4, 5.1, 5.3)</b> Postal Mail</p> <p>Provide a tissue box. Set up a table with paper, and pens. Have your child write to whom they are mailing the letter to and then place it into the tissue box provided.</p> 	<p><b>Construction (L.O 4.1, 5.1)</b> Toothpick and Marshmallow Sculptures</p>  <p>Provide toothpicks and mini marshmallows. Connect the toothpicks to the marshmallow to make a variety of things like a house</p>	<p><b>Fine Motor (L.O 1.3, 4.3)</b> Sticker Lines</p>  <p>Draw different lines (zig zag, wavy, straight) on a paper. Provide stickers or buttons or small rocks. Have your child place object along each line</p>	<p><b>Construction (L.O 4.1, 5.1, 5.4)</b> Cup Stacking</p> <p>Provide plastic cups. On a flat surface, start stacking the cups to make a pyramid without it falling.</p> 	<p><b>Sensory (L.O 1.3, 4.2, 5.1)</b> Taste Testing Flavours</p> <p>Provide your child with a variety of different food that has different flavours.</p> <p>Salty (potato chips, pretzels), sour (lemon, gummy worms), sweet (marshmallows, chocolate), spicy (salsa, gumdrops), bitter (dark chocolate, broccoli). Encourage your kids to try them and ask what flavour they taste? cup and insert a string into each hole.</p>
<p><b>Creative Arts (L.O 1.2, 4.1)</b> Mail/Letter Card DIY</p> <p>Provide coloured papers, colouring pencils, crayons, textas, glue, sticker. Have your child create their own mail card to a family member.</p>	<p><b>Music and Movement (L.O 3.1, 5.5)</b> Handkerchief Dancing</p> <p>Provide handkerchief (or any smaller piece of material) for children to hold. Turn on music and start dancing with</p>	<p><b>Creative Arts (L.O 1.2, 4.1, 5.1)</b> Creating your own story book.</p> <p>Ask your child to draw a picture or a couple of pictures and work with them to create their own story book.</p>	<p><b>Fine Motor (L.O 1.3, 4.3)</b> Clothes Peg Activity</p> <p>Provide a rectangle cardboard. Have your child peg on the clothing pegs around the cardboard. You can make it more challenging by labelling the pegs from numbers 1 to 10 and write down numbers 1 to 10 on the cardboard and have them match it up.</p>	<p><b>Environmental Sustainability (2.4, 4.4)</b> Can Shakers</p> <p>Provide recycled cans. Place rice or little rocks inside. Seal the opening with tape. Turn on some music and make some rhythm with the can shakers.</p>



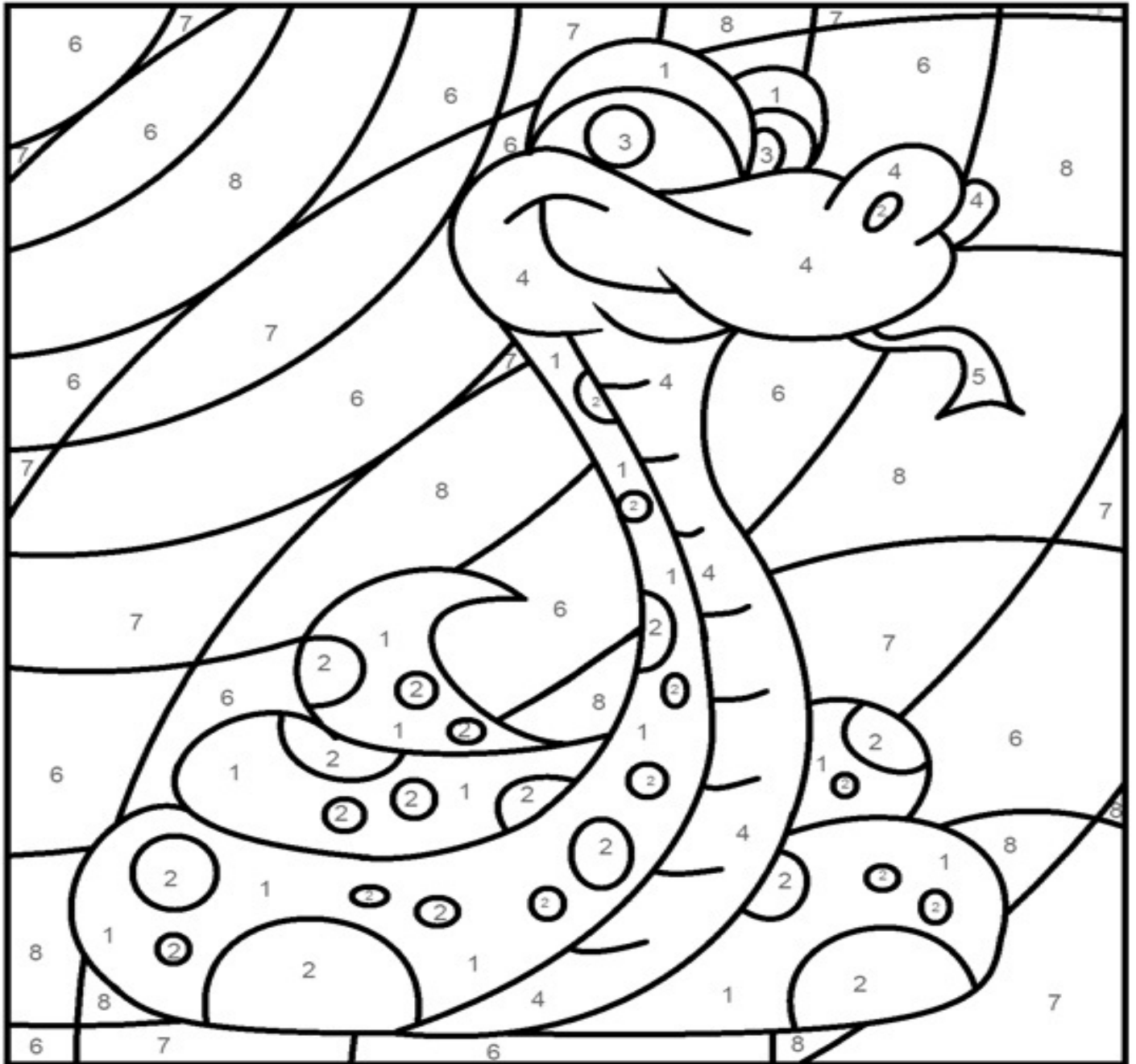

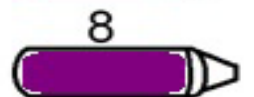
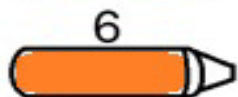
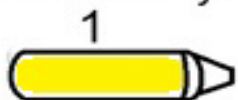
<p><b><u>Cooking (L.O 1.4, 4.4)</u></b> Honey Joys</p> <p>INGREDIENTS: 90g butter or margarine, 1/3 cup sugar, 1 tablespoon honey, 4 cups Corn Flakes</p> <p>METHOD: 1. Preheat oven to 150°C. 2. Line 24 hole patty pan with paper cases. 3. Melt butter, sugar and honey together in a saucepan until frothy. 4. Add Corn Flakes and mix well. 5. Working quickly spoon into paper patty cases. 6. Bake in a slow oven 150°C for 10 minutes.</p> 	<p><b><u>Science Experiment (L.O 4.2, 5.1)</u></b> Collect some things around your house and have a guess whether they are going to float or sink. Test it out in a bucket of water.</p> 	<p><b><u>Gross Motor (L.O 3.1, 3.2)</u></b> Grab a washing basket and a ball. Try and throw the ball into the basket. If it is too easy move a couple of steps back.</p> 	<p><b><u>Environmental Sustainability (2.4, 4.4)</u></b> Make monsters out of toilet rolls or paper towel rolls. These can be decorated with anything from beads, coloured paper, string ect.</p> 	<p><b><u>Gross Motor (L.O 3.1, 3.2)</u></b> Blow up a balloon and start to hit it with your hand. Try and keep balloon up in the air. Don't let it hit the ground.</p> 
<p><b><u>Dramatic Play (L.O 1.4, 5.1, 5.3)</u></b> Create some pretend food, eg cookies, ginger bread men, cakes Have the children set up a shop and have them sell you the food in their shop.</p> 	<p><b><u>Construction (L.O 4.1, 5.1)</u></b> What can you build with some Lego</p> 	<p><b><u>Fine Motor (L.O 1.3, 4.3)</u></b> Practice writing your name on the concrete with either chalk or with water and a paintbrush.</p> 	<p><b><u>Literacy (L.O 1.1, 5.1, 5.2)</u></b> Read a favourite story to your child.
